Additional Report C: Cost-Benefit Analysis

Every dollar spent on Warren County Drug Court helps save the County \$8.23 on incarceration per year. This amounts to a net savings of \$20,947.00 per person, per year (when \$2,544 is spent on Drug Court).



Calculated using incarceration and supervision rates published in the State of Tennessee Board of Probation and Parole Annual Report: 2008-2009. The Tennessee Department of Corrections Fiscal Year 2008-2009 average daily cost for incarceration was \$64.36 per inmate.
